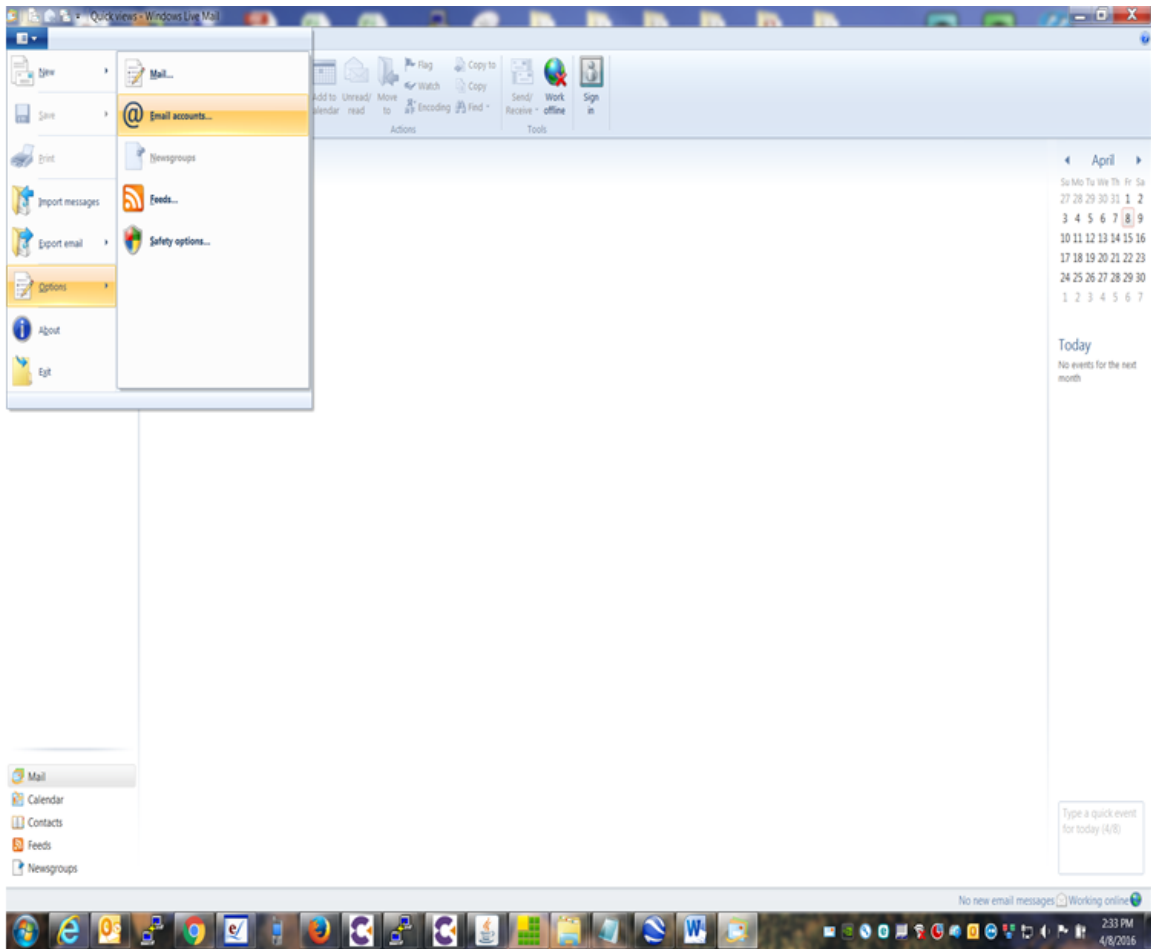
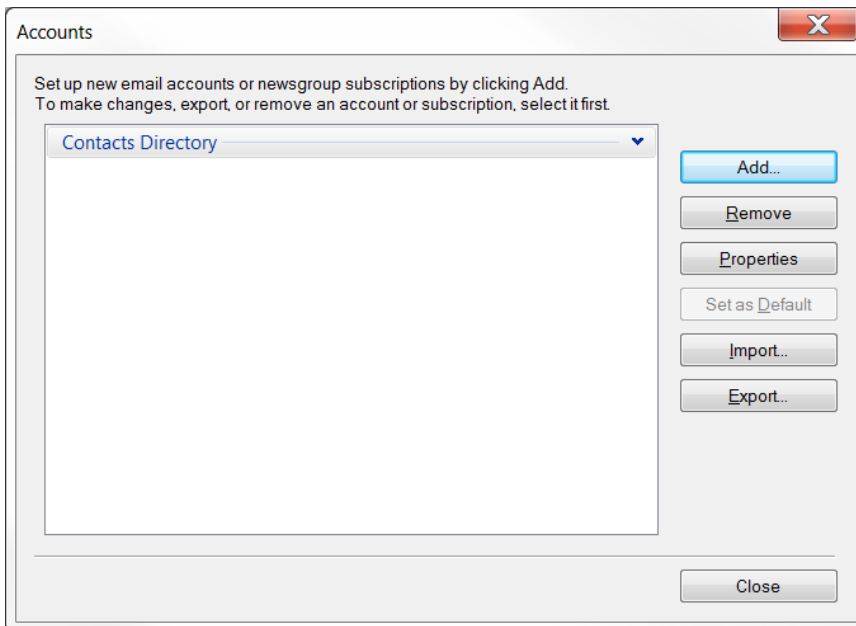


Windows Live Mail Setup

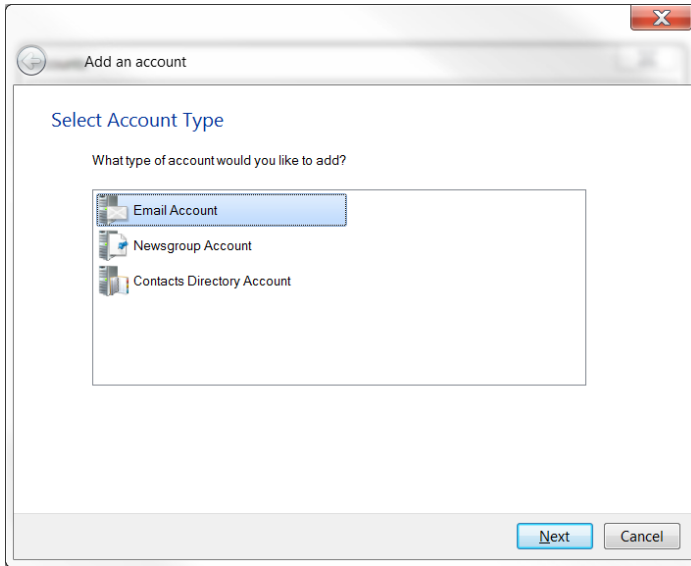
Open Windows Live Mail and click Options then Email accounts.



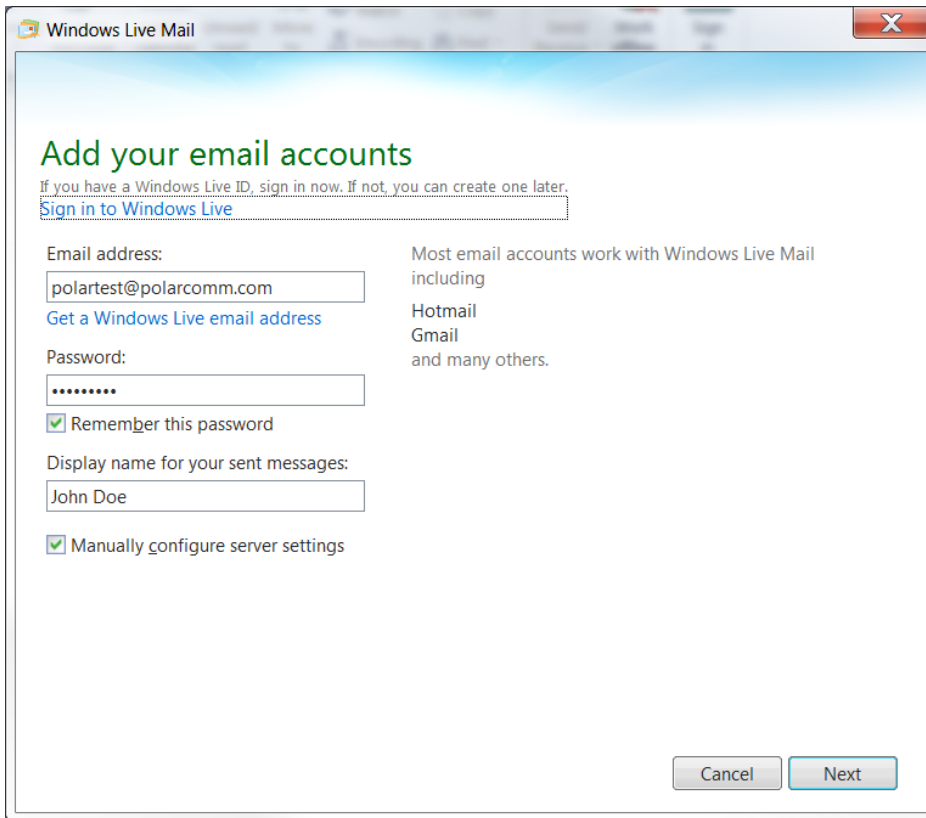
In this window, click “Add”




Select "Email Account" and click Next.



Type in your full email address and password and check Remember this password. Type in your name in the Display name for your sent messages. Choose "Manually configure server settings".



Select "IMAP" from the drop down box. For Server address type `imap.polarcomm.com` and check the box "Requires a secure connection SSL". Leave "clear text". Type in your email address again for "Logon user name". Type `imap.polarcomm.com` again for the Outgoing "Server address" and check both "Requires a secure connection SSL" and "Requires authentication". Click "Next".


