



# **2021 RDFC Grant Program**

The Rural Development Finance Corporation (RDFC) is pleased to announce it has approved a 2021 grant allotment of \$2,000 per member-cooperative to be used to support community owned entities, non-profits and community-based projects. As a member, Polar Communications encourages community projects in our service territory to apply for this funding.

### **Guidelines**:

**Eligible projects:** community owned businesses (café, grocery store, motel, other); community facilities (such as ambulance services, fire districts, recreation, hospital/clinic, community center, etc.); or community-based projects (such as school/youth projects, other) that benefit rural areas.

**Matching funds:** \$4 dollars of other funds to every \$1 of RDFC funds. Please provide matching fund information for verification.

**Maximum/minimum grant amounts:** The minimum grant amount is \$500; the maximum is \$2,000. The limit is \$2,000 per member cooperative for 2021.

Time frame: February 1, 2021 - December 31, 2021

# **Process:**

Applications and process information can be found on Polar Communications website at polarcomm.com/resources/#agreements. The application for funds needs to flow through Polar Communications. Once the RDFC Grant Application is received by Polar, it will be reviewed by the board of directors at the next regularly scheduled meeting. If the board votes to recommend the project for the RDFC Grant, the application will then be submitted to the RDFC Board for review. Applicants will be notified when submission information is returned to Polar Communications.
